Workshop on Gender Inclusion in Sanitation Service Delivery

Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE) is the national lead agency for the provision of drinking water Supply, Sanitation and Waste management in Bangladesh. Gender integration is crucial for ensuring safe water supply, sanitation services and waste management for accessible and equitable for all genders. With that view, DPHE has recently reformed the Gender and Development Forum (GDF) to provide technical assistance, and guidance projects to programs and regular activities to mainstream gender. For strengthening the purpose of gender inclusion in sanitation service delivery, a 2-days workshop titled "Gender Inclusion in Sanitation Service Delivery" was successfully organized jointly by the CWIS-FSM Support Cell, DPHE and ITN BUET with the consistent invaluable support of the Gender and Development Forum of DPHE. The workshop took place on May 13th and 14th, 2023, at the Rajendrapur BRAC CDM with the enthusiastic participation of DPHE officials. The effort aimed to enhance gender inclusion standards and promote sustainable and inclusive WASH services.







The Key Objective

- a. To develop common understanding of the gender and sanitation nexus, its evolution and concept, and practical implications in service provision, to ensure all participants are on the same pace and aware of the core issues at hand.
- b. To create "gender inclusion standards for DPHE services" related to WASH, DRR, FSM, and sanitation entrepreneurship based on policy analysis and practice-level findings.
- c. To develop a gender action plan for the Gender Development Forum (GDF), as it provides a clear roadmap for implementing the gender inclusiveness standards and promoting gender-sensitive practices within the targeted sectors.

- 2) Development process of the Comprehensive Gender Manual on WASH, DRR, FSM, and Sanitation Entrepreneurship.

- 4) Introducing Gender and Development Forum, DPHE and Gender Action Plan for the forum.
- 5) Practical implications of gender in sanitation service delivery.
